We have been notified of a COVID-19 case of an individual who attended Lamphere High School on February 4, 2021. The individual became symptomatic on February 8th, was tested, and found to be positive. The individuals deemed to be a close contact (6 feet or less for 15 minutes or longer with or without a mask) have been notified and will receive a separate letter providing specific guidance. This communication is for your awareness and you do not have restrictions according to the Oakland County Health Department.

COVID-19 is a contagious viral illness that spreads in the air through coughing, sneezing, and talking. Recent information suggests COVID-19 is spread by people who are not showing symptoms. It may be possible that a person can get COVID-19 by touching a surface or object that has the virus on it, then touching their own mouth, nose, or possibly their eyes. Symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.
