A teacher who was determined to be in close contact with a staff member who was previously positive has also tested positive for COVID-19. This teacher last attended Lamphere High School on October 19th. The student(s) and staff member(s) who were deemed to be in close contact with this individual will be notified and will receive a separate letter providing specific guidance. Close contact is defined as 6 feet or less for 15 minutes or longer with or without a mask. This communication is for your awareness.

COVID-19 is a contagious viral illness that spreads in the air through coughing, sneezing, and talking. Recent information suggests COVID-19 is spread by people who are not showing symptoms. It may be possible that a person can get COVID-19 by touching a surface or object that has the virus on it, then touching their own mouth, nose, or possibly their eyes. Symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, a new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.
